6.1 Course Name: BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (B.ED)

The B.Ed programme at Bhavan's Tripura Teacher Training College is a professional two-year degree course aimed at preparing effective secondary and higher secondary school teachers. It is designed in accordance with the norms and regulations of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) and affiliated to Tripura University. The course emphasizes pedagogical theory, practical training, and value-based education to develop skilled, reflective, and ethically grounded educators.

6.1.1 **Purpose:** To equip future teachers with the knowledge and skills necessary to teach effectively at secondary/senior secondary levels.

6.1.2 **Intake:** 100

6.1.3 **Duration:** 2 years (4 semesters)

6.1.4 **Medium of Instruction:** Bengali/English

6.1.5 **Mode:** Face to Face/Regular

6.1.6 **Eligibility:**

- Candidates with at least 50% marks (45% for reserved categories) in Bachelor's Degree / Master's Degree in Sciences / Social Sciences / Humanities.
- Candidates with a Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks are also eligible.

6.2 Course Name: DIPLOMA IN ELEMENTARY EDUCATION (D.EL.ED)

The D.El.Ed programme at Bhavan's Tripura Teacher Training College is a two-year full-time diploma course designed to prepare teachers for the elementary stage of education, i.e., Classes I to VIII. The course focuses on child-centric pedagogy, inclusive education, classroom management, and hands-on teaching experience. It is approved by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) and conducted as per the curriculum prescribed by SCERT Tripura.

6.2.6 **Eligibility:** Candidates with at least 50% marks in the Higher Secondary (+2 Stage) or its equivalent examination are eligible for admission to the D.El.Ed programme (relaxation up to 5% marks in case of SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates).

6.3 Course Name: BACHELOR OF ARTS (B.A)

The Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) programme at Bhavan's Tripura Teacher Training College is a four-year undergraduate degree designed to provide students with a comprehensive education in the fields of humanities and social sciences (Major subjects – Bengali, Education, History, Political Science). Aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the programme emphasizes multidisciplinary learning, critical thinking, communication skills, and ethical values.

6.3.6 **Eligibility:** Candidates must have passed the Higher Secondary (+2) or equivalent examination from a recognized board.

6.3.7 **Affiliation:** Affiliated to Tripura University (A Central University)

7. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- iv. **Merit List/Entrance Test:** Admission is granted based on merit or entrance test, as prescribed by the affiliating university and regulatory bodies.
- v. **Counselling and Verification:** Shortlisted candidates are invited for counselling, during which document verification and final admission formalities are completed.

12. RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR STUDENTS

- 12.1 Students shall have to secure minimum required percentage of attendance as prescribed by the affiliating bodies for all course work and practicum to appear in B.Ed/D.El.Ed/B.A examinations.
- 12.2 The minimum attendance of student-teachers shall have to be 90% for school internship programme.
- 12.3 Students shall have to attend classes according to the time-table prescribed by the college.
- 12.4 Students are required to carry identity card within the college premises.
- 12.5 Students are not permitted to leave / absent from the college without a prior permission.
- 12.6 A student will not be allowed to continue in the college if any one of the following is found at any point of time:
 - 12.6.1 *certificates of qualifying examinations submitted by him/her are not genuine.*
 - 12.6.2 *he/she does not maintain discipline in the college.*
 - 12.6.3 *his/her behaviour is not proper with the other students or staff of the college.*
- 12.7 If a student is found less than 80% of attendance in the class or remain absent in the college without any intimation to the college authority by 30 days from the date of beginning of the academic session, his/her admission will be automatically cancelled without any notice and one of the wait-listed candidates may take admission as per decision of the college authority.
- 12.8 Fees are to be deposited in the college A/C at Canara Bank as per the time scheduled by the college authority, failing which a fine will be levied on all late payments.
- 12.9 Admission fees once paid will not be returned in any circumstances.
